The Sonder Collective is a new kind of church ministry – an ecumenical collaborative youth and young adults ministry. We exist to serve along side churches as a resource for youth and young adults. For most church communities, affording niche ministry (or larger ministry programs, like camps) just is not feasible – though even one or two young people still need to be spiritually nurtured.

The Sonder Collective gifts our resources so young people from many churches communities can come together and uplift each of our home church communities every time we gather. Whether it is through ministry consultation, or by becoming a part of The Sonder Collective community, our aim is to operate so we are able to uplift each local congregation just as they are.

The Sonder Collective allows a greater ability for individual churches to look at what it means to grow as an intergenerational church community. By uplifting each home church, we are able to maintain our autonomy, maintain our pastoral care for each individual, but still be able to join in specified age-based ministry programs.

As The Sonder Collective is intentionally a collaborative space,

our leadership is brought together from each church community so young people across every church are able to enjoy community and programs that they may have missed out on previously.

Our intentional collaborative space allows a depth of christian thought and theology, with an aim to grow a deeper more compassionate faith, as we get to listen to the experience of many peoples expression of who Christ is in their life across our ecumenical landscape of churches.
